1. **Psalm 1 and 2**

¹Blessed *is* the man that <u>walketh</u> not in the <u>counsel</u> of the <u>ungodly</u>, nor standeth in the way of <u>sinners</u>, nor <u>sitteth</u> in the seat of the <u>scornful</u>.

²But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

³And he shall be <u>like</u> a <u>tree</u> planted by the <u>rivers</u> of <u>water</u>, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his <u>leaf</u> also shall not <u>wither</u>; and whatsoever he doeth shall <u>prosper</u>.

⁴The ungodly *are* not so: but *are* like the <u>chaff</u> which the wind driveth away.

⁵Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the <u>congregation</u> of the righteous.

⁶For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall <u>perish</u>.

¹Why do the heathen <u>rage</u>, and the people imagine a <u>vain</u> thing?

²The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, *saying*,

³Let us break their bands <u>asunder</u>, and cast away their cords from us.

 4 He that sitteth in the heavens shall <u>laugh</u>: the Lord shall have them in <u>derision</u>.

⁵Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore <u>displeasure</u>.

⁶Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

⁷I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou *art* my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

⁸Ask of me, and I shall give *thee* the heathen *for* thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth *for* thy possession.

⁹Thou shalt <u>break</u> them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

¹⁰Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be <u>instructed</u>, ye judges of the earth. ¹¹Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with <u>trembling</u>.

 12 Kiss the Son, lest he be <u>angry</u>, and ye perish *from* the way, when his wrath is <u>kindled</u> but a little. Blessed *are* all they that put their <u>trust</u> in him.
