## 2. Psalm 3 and 4

A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.

<sup>1</sup>LORD, how are they <u>increased</u> that <u>trouble</u> me! <u>many</u> *are* they that <u>rise</u> up against me.

<sup>2</sup>Many <u>there</u> be which say of my soul, *There is* no help for him in God. Selah.

<sup>3</sup>But thou, O LORD, *art* a <u>shield</u> for me; my <u>glory</u>, and the <u>lifter</u> up of <u>mine</u> head.

<sup>4</sup>I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.

<sup>5</sup>I laid me down and slept; I <u>awaked</u>; for the LORD sustained me.

<sup>6</sup>I will not be afraid of ten <u>thousands</u> of people, that have set *themselves* against me <u>round</u> about.

<sup>7</sup>Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast <u>smitten</u> all mine <u>enemies</u> *upon* the <u>cheek</u> bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

<sup>8</sup>Salvation *belongeth* unto the LORD: thy blessing *is* upon thy people. Selah.

To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm of David.

<sup>1</sup>Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast <u>enlarged</u> me when I was in <u>distress</u>; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.

<sup>2</sup>O ye sons of men, how long *will ye turn* my glory into shame? *how long* will ye love vanity, *and* seek after leasing? Selah.

<sup>3</sup>But know that the LORD hath set <u>apart</u> him that is godly for himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto him.

<sup>4</sup>Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.

<sup>5</sup>Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your <u>trust</u> in the LORD.

<sup>6</sup>There be many that say, Who will shew us any good? LORD, lift thou up the light of thy countenance upon us.

<sup>7</sup>Thou hast put <u>gladness</u> in my heart, more than in the time *that* their <u>corn</u> and their wine increased.

<sup>8</sup>I will both lay me <u>down</u> in <u>peace</u>, and <u>sleep</u>: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.
