¹Give ear to my <u>words</u>, O LORD, <u>consider</u> my <u>meditation</u>.

³My voice shalt thou <u>hear</u> in the morning, O LORD; in the <u>morning</u> will I direct *my prayer* unto thee, and will look up.

⁷But as for me, I will come *into* thy house in the multitude of thy mercy: *and* in thy <u>fear</u> will I <u>worship</u> toward thy holy <u>temple</u>.

⁸Lead me, O LORD, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way <u>straight</u> before my face.

⁹For *there is* no faithfulness in their <u>mouth</u>; their <u>inward</u> part *is* very wickedness; their <u>throat</u> *is* an open <u>sepulchre</u>; they <u>flatter</u> with their <u>tongue</u>.

¹⁰<u>Destroy</u> thou them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions; for they have <u>rebelled</u> against thee.

¹¹But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever <u>shout</u> for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be <u>joyful</u> in thee.

¹²For thou, LORD, wilt bless the <u>righteous</u>; with favour wilt thou compass him as *with* a shield.
